1. Q: According to the ceramic 09 30 00 gage 6, para. 3.3 requires the wall tile to be installed in accordance with TCA HdBk method W221. Per this method, the wall tile is to be installed on a mud-bed with a metal lath. The tile specified does not have the appropriate mud-set trim available. Please advise.

1. A: Tile is to be set on mud bed and lath.

Sheet A-601 on the Color & Material Selection chart replace the porcelain tile with:

Sleeping room toilet/showers: American Olean Highland Ridge "Desert" HR50 6"x6" through body porcelain wall and floor tile and corresponding 2"x2" mosaic tile for shower floor.

Specification: 09 30 00 - 2.1.2 Porcelain Tile - Change 8"x8" nominal size to 6"x6" nominal size.

Other tile selection:

Daltile - Aspen Lodge, "Morning Breeze" AL60

Marazzi - Walnut Canyon "Cream"

2. Q: Sheet E-101, typically there are DCC control panels at each AHU. Are we to install a new power circuit 120 Vac at each AHU Room for control power? If so, please indicate sub panel source.

2. A: AHU-1 and 2 DDC control panels to be fed from circuit LA-42. AHU-3 and 4 DDC control panels to be fed from circuit LC-42. AHU-5 and 6 DDC control panels to be fed from circuit LE-42.

3. Q: Sheet M-602, shows an existing chiller on the system network and on sheet M-601 Sequence of operation talks about a steam to hot water exchanger. We can't find these items on the contract dwgs or on the schedules. Please clarify.

3. A: Both of these items are existing. The chiller serves multiple buildings in the area. The steam to water heat exchanger is located in a mechanical room approximately 60' from the building. For this job the dual temperature piping will be picked up in the existing laundry room on the 1st floor. No work is to be done on the existing chiller and steam to water heat exchanger.
